Waste Rules

You must sort waste in order to recycle items that can be used as resources.



Iwata City has certain rules established to keep the city clean.

Waste Sorting P3~8

Please divide into nine categories

- ① Combustible Waste
- ② Plastic Containers and Packaging
- ③ Empty Cans
- ④ Empty Bottles
- ⑤ PET Bottles
- ⑥ Waste Cooking Oil
- ⑦ Hardware & Small Appliances
- ⑧ Harmful Waste
- ⑨ Landfill Waste



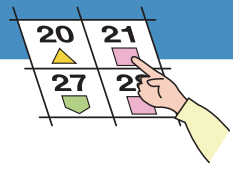

Waste Collection Days

Put out waste for collection on the designated day on the household waste collection calendar.



Waste Collection Times

Put waste out for collection until 8:00 am. during the day of pickup



Waste Disposal Area

Please follow the guidelines for your district when putting out waste by type within the designated areas.

Waste that was not put out according to the rules will be affixed with a "Request Sticker" and will not be collected.

- Not properly sorted
- Put out on the wrong day

If any waste is left by the collectors, check it again and put it out correctly.



Waste left by the collectors with a request sticker



Failure to do so will be a nuisance to the person in charge of the waste collection point.



Request Sticker

Unauthorized appropriation of recycling waste and other items is prohibited.

According to the "Iwata City Ordinance on the Reduction and Propriety of Waste", taking waste that other people have put in waste collection sites is prohibited.



Illegal dumping of waste is a crime.

Illegal dumping is a violation of the "Waste Disposal and Public Cleansing Law", and may be subject to penalties. (Imprisonment of not more than 5 years or a fine of not more than ¥10,000,000)



When your dog or other pet die

●To request cremation of a pet by city hall, place your pet in a cardboard box, and bring it to the Environment Section or Branch Civic Life Division. It will be cremated with other pets. Cremains cannot be returned to the owner.

Fee: ¥4,400 (As of April 1st, 2023)

Reception: Monday - Friday 8:30 - 17:15

*Outside of normal weekday hours, please bring your pet to the night shift office of city hall or a branch office.

Bring: If you have registered your dog, bring your dog notebook, dog license, and vaccination documents. Please submit a notice of dog death.

① Purchase designated bags. (colorless)



Wash lightly with water to remove waste. Put stained items in **combustible waste**

How to dispose of empty cans, empty bottles, PET bottles, and waste cooking oil

Empty Cans

Aluminum cans / Steel cans

① Wash lightly with water.



② Place in the designated container.

You can throw out the lid too.



Food and beverage cans

Cassette-style gas cylinders and spray cans

① Use all the contents



Do not cut a hole.

② Put this in the spray can container!

Failure to do so can cause a fire in the waste truck!

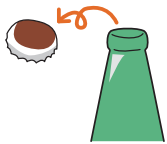

Empty Bottles

Metal lids ⇒ In "Hardware & Small Appliances"
Plastic lids ⇒ In "Plastic Containers and Packaging"

① Remove the lid.



② Wash lightly with water.



③ Place bottles by color in a designated receptacle.

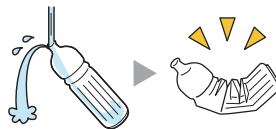
PET Bottles

Cap and label ⇒ In "Plastic Containers and Packaging"

① Remove the caps and labels.



② Wash lightly with water. Crush into as small a size as possible.



③ Place in a designated container.



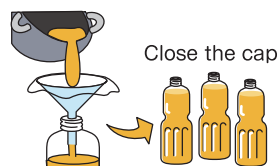
Items with this mark

Used tempura oil, etc.

① After being used for deep frying tempura, etc., cooking oil should be cooled, and impurities such as scraps should be removed.



② Put this oil in a PET bottle



Close the cap

③ Place in a designated container.



Animal oil, machine oil, gasoline, etc. are not applicable

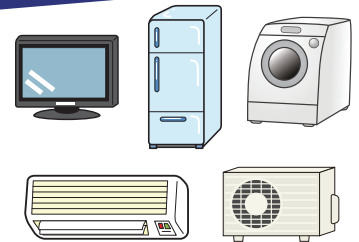
Home appliance manufacturers are obliged to recycle items covered by the Home Appliance Recycling Law. Please dispose of them by the following methods. You cannot bring them to waste collection points or municipal facilities as household waste.

Method of Disposal

1 Ask the store where you bought your appliance or where you will buy a new product to take the old product.

If you will buy a new product, then ask the store to take the old product.

2 Take it to a designated collection site.

Check the name of the manufacturer, then pay the recycling fee at a post office. (Recycling Fee + Payment Fee)

Bring the appliance recycling sticker you received together with the waste appliance to a designated reception point.

1 Collectable Items

Size

For each item to be collected, the longest part is 2 meters or less, and the weight is 60 kg or less.

Examples of items that can be collected

- Drawers, futons, bicycles, desks, beds, mattresses, organs, sofas, etc.
- If you put items in a bag, then sort them in the same way that you would when putting them in a waste collection point.
Use a designated bag or a clear bag that shows the contents, and only put it in as much as one person can lift.
- Items subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law (TVs, air conditioners, refrigerators and freezers, clothes washers and clothes dryers)

* For items subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law, pay the recycling fee at a post office and get an appliance recycling sticker by the collection date. →P12

Items that cannot be collected

Waste that exceed the stipulated length and weight and waste that cannot be processed by the city

2 Application method

Application period

Generally, at least 2 weeks before your desired collection date
(Depending on the state of reservations, your desired date may be unavailable)

Where to apply

Call the Waste Disposal Section at 0538-37-4812 to make a reservation.

Please give your address, name, telephone number, and the type, quantity, and size of waste you will put out.

Notes of Importance

- ① Collection dates are Monday to Friday. (Excluding public holidays and New Year's holidays)
- ② Put waste in front of your house in advance. (Or on the 1st floor in housing complexes)
The waste collectors cannot go into your house to carry waste out.
- ③ You or a family member must be present on the collection date.
- ④ Generally, use of this service is limited to once per month per household.

3 Collection Fees

Fees

Basic Fee: ¥1,040, + ¥210 per item collected

(Ex.) 4 items: ¥1,040 + (¥210 × 4 items) = ¥1,880

* Items subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law incur an additional ¥1,100 fee for transportation to the designated collection point.

Payment Methods

Pay in cash at the time of collection (Please prepare exact change)

● There is a fee exemption system.

- Households which only have members aged 70 or older (Excluding separated households)
- Households which only have members that have received physical disability certificate levels 1 to 3

If you meet the above criteria and a social worker has issued a discount/exemption application on your behalf, then you will be exempt from the basic fee of ¥1,040.

*Collection fees are current as of April 2020. Prices are subject to change.



Vehicles up to 2 tons

Self-delivery (bring directly to a disposal facility)

If you have a large volume of waste produced when moving, or large waste that you cannot put in a waste collection point, or if you cannot put waste in the waste collection point because of your job, please bring it directly to the waste disposal facility.

Vehicles are limited to 2 tons or less.

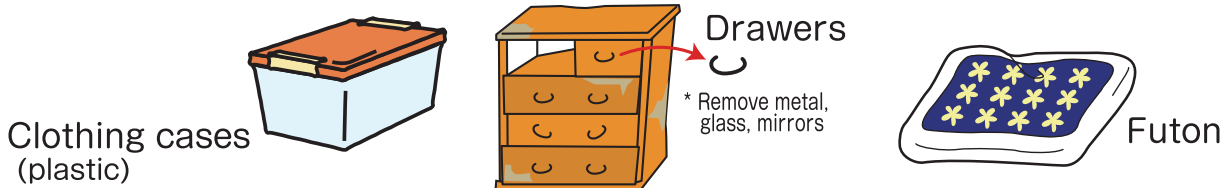

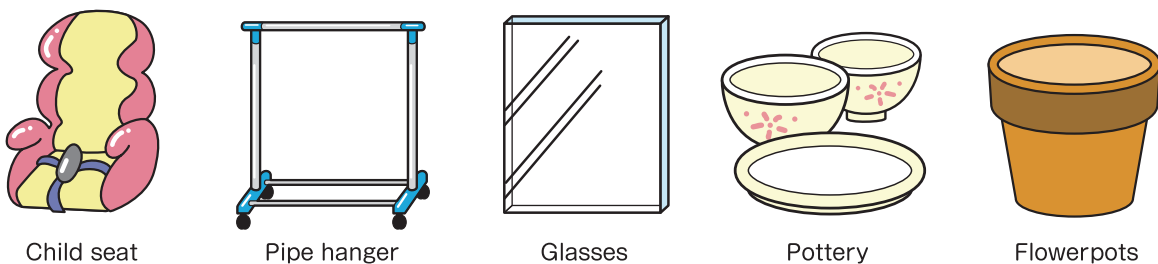

What should I do with waste after an emergency?

■ Disaster strikes! What should I do with waste?

Please sort

Make certain to sort waste, even after a disaster!
In order to ensure rapid recovery, it is important that you sort your waste.



Pay attention to information from the city.

The rules for disposing of waste are subject to change depending on the state of the disaster. Notices will be made on the city website, etc.

■ Waste produced after a disaster can be divided into “household waste” and “disaster waste”.

Normal Household Waste



Depending on the state of the disaster, household waste collection may be temporarily suspended.

Notices will be made on the city website.

Once restarted

Combustible waste will be collected first

Waste collection will be restarted giving priority to “Combustible Waste”, such as kitchen waste, portable toilets (properly treated with coagulant). Put it in a waste collection point after you see notice of the restart of collection.



What about other household waste?

Sort and store other household waste in your house until you see notice of the restart of collection, including plastic containers and packaging, empty cans, empty glass bottles, PET bottles, used cooking oil, hardware and small appliances, harmful waste, and landfill waste.

Disaster Waste

Disaster waste refers to furniture and appliances broken in a disaster, as well as wood, metal, and tiles from wrecked houses.

If there is a large volume of disaster waste, then waste collection points will be established in different places than usual.

Notices will be made on the city website.

Once established

Sort and take directly to a collection point designated by the city.

Depending on the state of the disaster, the city will designate places where you can take disaster waste, called “kariokiba”.

Make certain to sort your waste first.
