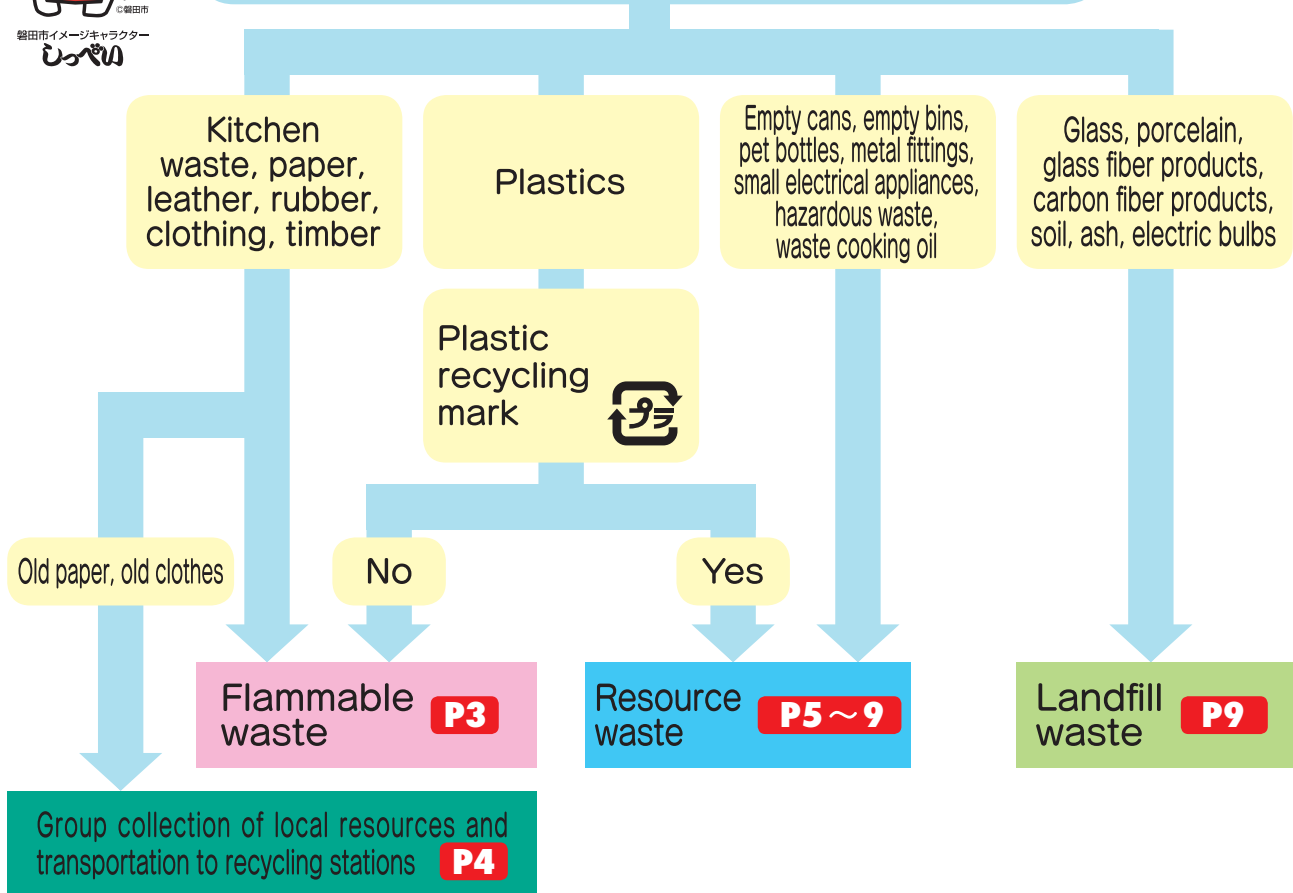

How is household waste sorted?



Reduce the volume before taking out the waste!

About 90% of household waste is flammable waste, 50% of which is kitchen waste containing water. Water makes the waste heavier and results in lower fuel efficiency in the waste collection vehicles and lower combustion efficiency. Before throwing away your kitchen waste, we request that you lower the waste volume by squeezing out the water.

In addition, among the things that you throw out unconsciously, there are many objects that can be recycled with just a little bit of extra effort. Let's practice the "3R" to reduce the amount of waste generated.

Reduce

First, cut down on the things that become waste

- Do not use and throw away
- Do not take more than what is necessary
- Carry your own shopping bags
- Use refillable products
- Eliminate over-buying, over-use and food leftovers

Reuse

Next, treasure and use things well

- Choose long-lasting products
- Pass usable things to others when you don't need them anymore
- Make use of recycling shops etc.

Recycle

Finally, use them as resources again

- Sort waste correctly – "waste" when mixed and "resources" when sorted
- Bring your waste to the group collection centers for local resources
- Bring your waste to store collection centers such as supermarkets etc.

Basic Rules when Taking Out Waste

◆Waste Collection Points

- The places where you can take out your waste (waste collection points) are fixed with your area. Never take out your waste to places other than the designated waste collection points.
- For those who have just moved in and are not aware of the waste collection points, please check with your neighbors or the building management company (owner) on where these are.

◆Waste Collection Days

- Check the “Household Waste Collection Calendar” for the waste collection days and take out your waste **before 8am on the day of collection.**

The date and time may be separately fixed by the neighborhood council. Make sure you check with your neighborhood council on the actual collection date and time.

※The “Household Waste Collection Calendar” for the following year is distributed through the neighborhood councils at the end of the year. Those who do not have it may get a copy from the central office, various branch offices, or the Clean Center. Alternatively, you may also see it on the website of the city.

◆How to Sort Your Waste

- Make sure the waste is put into the designated bags and then tie up the bags. **Write down your name and name of your district on the bags.**

There are two types of bags used. The green one is used for flammable waste while the colorless and transparent one is used for inflammable waste.

(For empty cans, empty bins, pet bottles, waste cooking oil, hazardous waste such as batteries etc., do not place them in the designated bags but in the containers located at the collection points.)

Follow the rules of your neighborhood council in writing down the name of your district. For those living in apartment buildings, write down the name of your apartment building, room number and your name.



For flammable waste For nonflammable waste Collection coupon

- For objects too big to be put into the designated bags, write down your name and district name in the collection coupon and attach it directly to the object before taking it out.
- The designated bags and collection coupon are on sale at supermarkets, convenience stores, drug stores, home centers etc.

◆ Size of waste that can be taken to the waste collection point

● Flammable waste

Objects 50cm or less in length

For larger objects, cut or disassemble into pieces smaller than 50cm.

※For tree branches, cut them into pieces 50cm in length and 20cm in thickness.

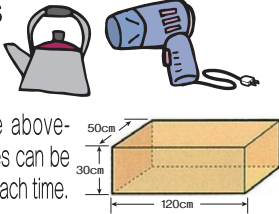


● Metal fittings, small electrical appliances, landfill waste

For objects that measure 120cmx 50cmx30cm or less

Cut or disassemble objects that exceed this size.

※Although bicycles exceed the above-mentioned size, up to two bicycles can be taken out to the collection point each time.



For objects that exceed the size that can be taken out to the waste collection point and those that are too heavy to be carried by one person, please carry them yourself to the waste disposal facility.

→ P11

For waste taken out without following the rules

Waste that has been sorted wrongly or taken out without your name or district name being written down will be left behind in the waste collection point with a request sticker pasted on it.

Waste left behind in the waste collection point has to be promptly taken back by you to be taken out again in accordance with the rules.

If the waste has been sorted incorrectly, remove the wrong waste and mark the request sticker with an X before taking it out for collection on the next collection day.

Note that the bag may tear if you try to peel away the sticker by force due to its strong adhesive.



Illegal dumping is a crime

Dumping waste on roads, rivers, empty lands, etc., is prohibited under the "Waste Disposal and Public Cleansing Law". Illegal dumping in violation of this law may be punishable by imprisonment of not more than 5 years or a fine of not more than 10 million yen, or a cumulative imposition of both.

Removing resource waste

Removing resource waste from the waste collection point is prohibited under the "Iwata City's Regulations on Waste Reduction and Appropriate Disposal". Illegal removal of resource waste from the waste collection point in violation of this regulation may be punishable by a fine not exceeding 200,000 yen or publication of the name of the offender.

For those who happen to witness such illegal removal, please contact the Waste Treatment Department with the date and time, venue, characteristics, etc. Do not stop or follow the offender as contact with such parties may be dangerous.

Flammable Twice weekly

- Put the waste into the green designated bags before taking it out.
- Paste the collection coupon directly onto the waste.
- Up to 2 bags and 2 bundles can be taken out each time.

Targeted at flammable materials not exceeding 50cm in length.

- Cut large and long objects into pieces not exceeding 50cm in length.
- Plastic products exceeding 50cm in length that cannot be put into the designated bags shall be disposed of as landfill waste. **→ P9**
- Large wooden furniture and plastic products as well as bulky flammable waste shall be brought to the Clean Center on your own. **→ P11**

● Kitchen waste

Raw garbage, leftover rice, shells etc.



※ Remove the water content.

● Waste paper, disposable diapers

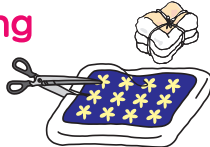


※ Throw away the stains in the toilet.

☑ Old papers (newspaper, magazines, miscellaneous paper, cardboard) are valuable resources. Let's take them to the resource collection groups and recycling stations etc. **→ P4 · 14**

● Fabric and clothing

Futon, blanket, carpet, curtain, clothing etc.



※ Cut objects like futons into pieces less than 50cm long and paste a collection coupon after tying them up into a bundle using a string. Bring the objects yourself if they cannot be cut up. **→ P11**

Do not cut up down-filled futons but tie them up tightly with a string.

☑ Bring recyclable clothing to the resource collection groups and recycling stations etc. **→ P4 · 14**

● Wooden waste

Tree branches, grass, fallen leaves, wooden products etc.

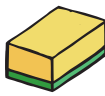


※ Cut tree branches into pieces not exceeding 50cm in length and 20 cm in thickness. Tie them up in a bundle with a string and paste the collection coupon.
 ※ 2 bags of grass, fallen leaves and other flammable waste can be separately taken out.

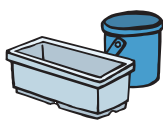

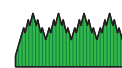

Objects with the plastic recycling mark, and objects whose stains cannot be removed with light cleaning (Example) Mayonnaise containers and toothpaste tubes etc.

※ Remove metallic parts from objects with metal fittings. Those whose fittings cannot be removed shall be treated as **[Metal Fittings, Small Electrical Appliances]** **→ P8**



Plastic containers and packaging with the plastic recycling mark shall be taken out on the collection day for "Plastic Containers and Packaging" (**P5**) after removing the stains.

Cooperation in the Recycling of Old Papers and Old Clothing

Old paper and old clothing are valuable resources which can be recycled. Let's take them to the resource collection groups and recycling stations instead of treating them as "flammable waste".

■ Recycling of old paper

Use a paper string to tie up newspapers (including advertising flyers), magazines, miscellaneous paper (including milk packs) and cardboard.

● What is miscellaneous paper?

This refers to "recyclable paper" other than newspaper, magazines and cardboard.

Insert them into magazines or put them into paper bags and then tie them up with a paper string.



Memo paper, Copying paper



Empty boxes for pastry, tissue etc.



Paper bags



Postcards, envelopes, name cards

✕ Paper other than miscellaneous paper → Treat as "Flammable Waste"

Thermal paper, carbon paper, non-carbon paper, vinyl-coated paper, crimped postcard, photos, tissue, drink boxes whose interior is silver in color, paper with waterproof finishing (paper cups, paper plates, yogurt containers etc.)

※The cellophane in the window area of envelopes is treated as "Flammable Waste".

■ Recycling of old clothing

After cleaning and drying, put the old clothing into transparent polyethylene bags and paper bags etc.

● What are old clothing and cloths?

Household clothing, sheets, towels, etc.

✕ Old clothing that cannot be recycled → Treat as "Flammable Waste"

Stained or smelly clothing, futon, floor cushion, blanket, curtain, carpet, etc.

■ How to take out old papers, old clothing

① Make use of local resource collection groups such as the neighbourhood council, PTA, children's club, etc.

Depending on the organization, the group may not be involved in the collection of old clothing.

Check the city's website below if you are not sure of the collection schedule of the local resource collection groups.

Plastic Containers and Packaging

(Resource Plastic)

Once a week

- Put these into the colorless and transparent designated bags.
- Up to 4 bags can be taken out each time.

Plastic containers and packaging that are used to store products and are no longer needed when the contents have been used up.

Applicable to those objects with the plastic recycling mark.



This mark serves as a guide.

● Cups and packs

Cup noodles, bento boxes, foodstuff and daily necessities packs etc.



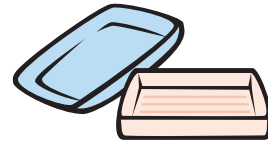
● Polyethylene bags, wrapping

Plastic packaging and bags for foodstuff and daily necessities, wrapping



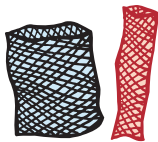
● Trays

Food trays etc.



● Nets

Plastic nets for foodstuff



● Bottles

Plastic bottles for foodstuff and daily necessities



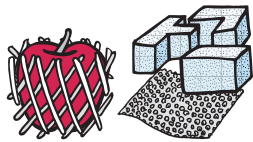
● Tubes

Plastic tubes for foodstuff and daily necessities



● Cushioning materials

Styrofoam, bubble wrap etc.



※ Cut the styrofoam into pieces small enough to be put inside the designated bags.

● Caps

Caps for pet bottles, containers, etc.

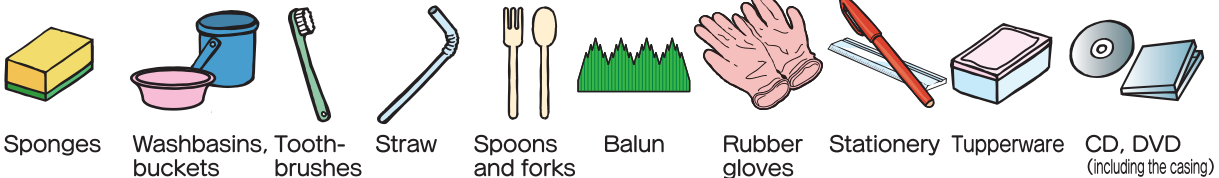


※ Metallic caps are treated as "Metal Fittings, Small Electrical Appliances".

Objects which cannot be recycled (those without the plastic recycling mark)

→ Treat as flammable waste P3

● Plastic products



Cassette tapes, video tapes (including the casing)



Packaging band, vinyl string



Objects with the plastic recycling mark but whose stains cannot be removed



Plastic toys (those that work on electricity or batteries shall be treated as "Metal Fittings, Small Electrical Appliances")

● Other objects for which the plastic recycling mark does not apply



Cleaning bags (non-product packaging)



Cocoon-shaped cushioning materials, styrofoam beads

Things to note when taking out your waste

① Check the “Plastic Recycling Mark”

The PP or PE displayed at the side of the plastic recycling mark indicates the plastic material used.

All objects with the plastic recycling mark are recyclable regardless of the material used.

There may be no mark on individual trays and internal packaging and the mark may be displayed on only the outer packaging.



② Finish using the contents and remove any stains.

Rinse stained objects lightly with water or wipe away the stains with a piece of cloth or paper.

As stained objects may result in problems during recycling, **treat the waste as flammable waste if the stains cannot be easily removed.**



③ Put the waste directly into the designated bags before taking it out.

Do not take out the waste in double bags (putting the waste in another bag such as a disposable bag first before putting it into the designated bag)


Waste taken out in double bags cannot be collected as it is not possible to verify whether the waste is stained or contains foreign bodies. Never do so as this may result in malfunction during the recycling or removal process of the foreign bodies after collection.

Why do we need to sort the waste?

The sorting and collection of “plastic containers and packaging” is governed by the “Containers and Packaging Recycling Law”.

The allocation of roles for (1) the consumer to sort and take out the waste, (2) the city to collect the waste, and (3) the business operator (manufacturer) making and using the containers and packaging to recycle the waste at its cost is defined under this law.  The plastic recycling mark is attached as “proof” that the recycling cost is being borne by the business operator.

Plastic products other than plastic containers and packaging are not applicable as the cost allocation and recycling structure has not been put in place. These will be collected as flammable waste separately from plastic containers and packaging.

Why can't the waste be stained or contaminated by foreign bodies?







As mentioned above, the cost for the recycling of “plastic containers and packaging” is mostly borne by the business operators (manufacturers) making and using the containers and packaging. When the waste is stained or mixed with foreign contaminants, this may result in problems occurring during recycling. As a result, the waste handed over by the city to the recycling operator is inspected every year and if the results are not satisfactory, the operator may refuse to take over the waste. In this case, the disposal cost has to be fully borne by the city. We therefore ask for your cooperation in removing stains from the waste and preventing it from being mixed with foreign contaminants. “Plastic containers and packaging” whose stains cannot be removed should be treated as flammable waste.

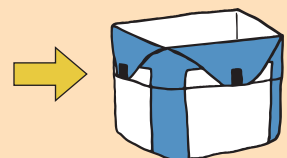
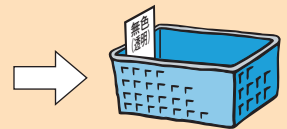
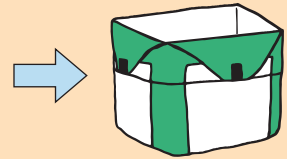


Empty Cans, Empty Bottles, Pet Bottles **Once a week**

Put into the containers at the waste collection points

Be sure to rinse lightly with water before taking out the waste.
Put the waste into the designated container.

Item	How to take out the waste	
Empty cans Aluminium cans Steel cans Food & beverage cans 	Take out the lids together with the beverage cans. Push the lid inside the can for tin cans. Cans above 18 liters in volume should be taken out as "Metal Fittings, Small Electrical Appliances".	
	Spray cans Gas cans Hairdressing products, insecticide, cartridge cylinders  → P9	Place it in the spray can container after using all the contents, without punching holes in the can.
Empty bottles Colorless (transparent) Colorless, transparent bottles for food and beverages, cosmetics. 	Bottles are recycled according to their colors so sort the bottles by the color of the mouth. Take out milky white bottles as "landfill waste"

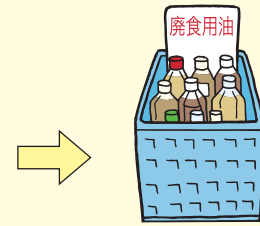


Resource Waste

Waste Cooking Oil **Once a month**

○Put into the containers at the waste collection points

Item	How to take out the waste
Applicable to vegetable oils that are no longer required at home Salad oil, olive oil, sesame oil, etc. ※Animal oil, machine oil, vehicle oil, gasoline, etc. are not applicable	Pour into a transparent container such as a pet bottle and securely fasten the lid before taking it out. (Do not pour the oil into a bottle that may break or a container for edible oil which may open up during collection. However, if it has not been opened, the waste can be taken out in the original bottle or can) 



Waste cooking oil will be refined and turned into fuel for the waste collection vehicles as bio-diesel fuel (BDF)



Resource Waste

Metal Fittings, Small Electrical Appliances **Once a month**

○Put the waste into the colorless, transparent designated bags before taking it out.
○Paste the collection coupon directly onto the waste.
○Up to 3 bags or 3 pieces can be taken out each time.

Applicable to objects not exceeding 120cmx50cmx30cm in size. (excluding bicycles)

For objects larger than this size, bring the items on your own to the processing facility for bulky waste in the Chuto wide area. **→P11**

Paste the collection coupon onto objects that cannot be put into the designated bags.

Although the collection day is the same as hazardous waste, put them into separate bags.

●Metallic products

Pot, kettle, frying pan, knife, steel drums, metallic lids, etc.



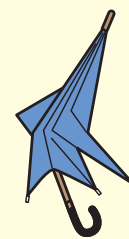
※Wrap the cutting edge of a knife with paper or cloth for safety reasons.

●Bicycle

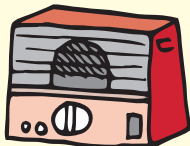


※Up to two bicycles can be taken out at a time.

●Umbrella



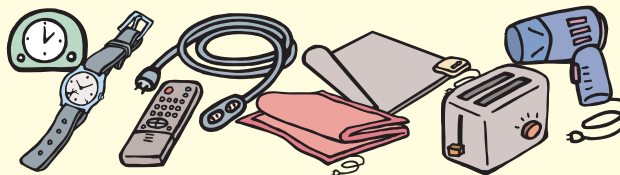
●Stove



※Drain away the kerosene and remove the batteries.

●Small electrical appliances

Vacuum cleaner, microwave, fan, DVD player, dryer, remote controller, electric blanket, electric carpet, electric cord, clock, printer, word processor, etc.



※PCs and mobile phones are collected at dedicated collection boxes located in the city's public facilities. **→P15**

※Electrical appliances such as TVs, air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, dryer, etc., subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law cannot be taken out to the waste collection points. **→P16**

Hazardous Waste **Once a month**

- Put these into the colorless and transparent designated bags.
- Place batteries in the containers located at the waste collection points.

Although the collection day is the same as metal fittings and small electrical appliances, put the waste into separate bags.

● Batteries

Dry cells, button batteries, rechargeable batteries



● Fluorescent tubes



※ Put tubes that cannot be put into the designated bags into a packaging box and paste a collection coupon on the box.
 ※ Take out LED fluorescent tubes as "Metal Fittings, Small Electrical Appliances". Take out incandescent lamps, electric bulbs and LED lights as "Landfill Waste".

● Thermometers (containing mercury)



※ Remove the batteries from electronic thermometers and take them out as "Metal Fittings, Small Electrical Appliances".



Landfill Waste **Once a month**

- Put these into the colorless and transparent designated bags.
- Paste the collection coupon directly onto the waste.
- Up to 2 bags or 2 pieces can be taken out each time.

Applicable to objects not exceeding 120cm x 50cm x 30cm in size.

For objects larger than this size, bring the items on your own to the final disposal site for general waste or processing facility for bulky waste in the Chuto wide area. However, plastic products exceeding 50cm in length are to be self-carried to the Clean Center **→P11**

Paste the collection coupon onto objects that cannot be put into the designated bags.

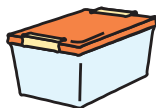

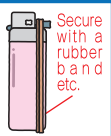


For large plastic products that are within 120x50x30 cm that will not fit in the designated bags, attach a collection coupon and put it out on landfill waste day.
 * If transporting such waste yourself, bring it to the Clean Center.

* Plastic products of a size that fit in the designated bags should be put in bags and put out on the flammable waste day.

How to release the gas

Press down on the operating lever and secure with a rubber band or adhesive tape in an outdoor area with good ventilation. Leave it for half a day or a day and then check that it no longer lights up.



Use the contents completely of spray cans and lighters!

Spray cans, disposable lighters and gas cylinders used in portable gas stoves etc. use flammable gas and thus they may result in an explosion and fire when being taken out as waste without releasing the gas inside. Fire incidents have occurred frequently in collection vehicles during the regular collection runs by the city.

Fires may result in injuries to the waste collection workers and damages to the collection vehicles. They may also inflict damages to surrounding housing and pedestrians in the event of a large explosion or blaze occurring.

● Things to note when taking out

Spray cans → Use the contents completely and put them in the spray can container on the "Empty Cans" day, without punching holes in the can.

Lighters → Finish using and release the gas before taking the plastic ones out as "Landfill Waste" and the metallic ones as "Metal Fittings and Small Electrical Appliances".



Make sure you remove gas in an outdoor area with good ventilation!



Things that Cannot be Taken to Waste Collection Centers

- Desktop PCs, notebook PCs
(including standard accessories included during purchase such as the keyboard, mouse, speaker, cables, etc. When disposing of these accessories alone, take them out as "Metal Fittings and Small Electrical Appliances".)

⑥ Commercial Waste

waste from commercial establishments such as shops, offices, factories, food and beverage outlets, agriculture industry, hospitals, etc.

Business operators discharging the waste are required by law to "treat the waste in an appropriate manner at their own responsibility". The city will only collect household waste and thus commercial waste cannot be taken out to the waste collection points.

- **Commercial flammable waste**
→ Bring the waste on your own to the Clean Center or engage the services of an operator licensed to collect and transport general waste (see the city's website for a list of the licensed operators)
- **Industrial waste**

Self-Carry (direct to the processing facility)

For large volumes of household waste that is generated occasionally due to house moving, spring cleaning, mowing, garden maintenance, etc., bulky waste that cannot be taken out to the waste collection points, and waste that cannot be taken out at the appointed time for work reasons etc., please bring them directly to the processing facility. Unloading of waste from the vehicle shall be carried out on your own. Transport vehicles are limited to those under 2 tons.

1 Flammable waste

Charges Apply

Waste that can be taken out : Raw garbage, waste paper, wood chips, wooden furniture, tatami mats, futon, plants and branches, plastic products, leather products, rubber products, sponges, etc.

Self-Carry Destination : Clean Center [Location map ① of self-carry destination](#)

Operating Hours : Mon-Fri, 8:30-16:15 / 2nd and 4th Sun, public holidays, 8:30-12:45 (excluding New Year holidays)

Processing Charges : 154 yen for every 10 kg

Size : Not exceeding 2m in length, wood branches not exceeding 20cm in diameter, up to 20 tatami mats per day

Others : Remove metals, glass and mirrors before bringing in the waste.

2 Empty cans, empty bottles, pet bottles, plastic containers and packaging, waste cooking oil, old paper, old clothing

Free of Charge

Limited to self-carry items, collection of old paper and old clothing that is not collected during the regular collection runs by the city is available.

Waste that can be taken out : Empty cans, empty bottles, pet bottles, waste cooking oil → Put into the dedicated containers

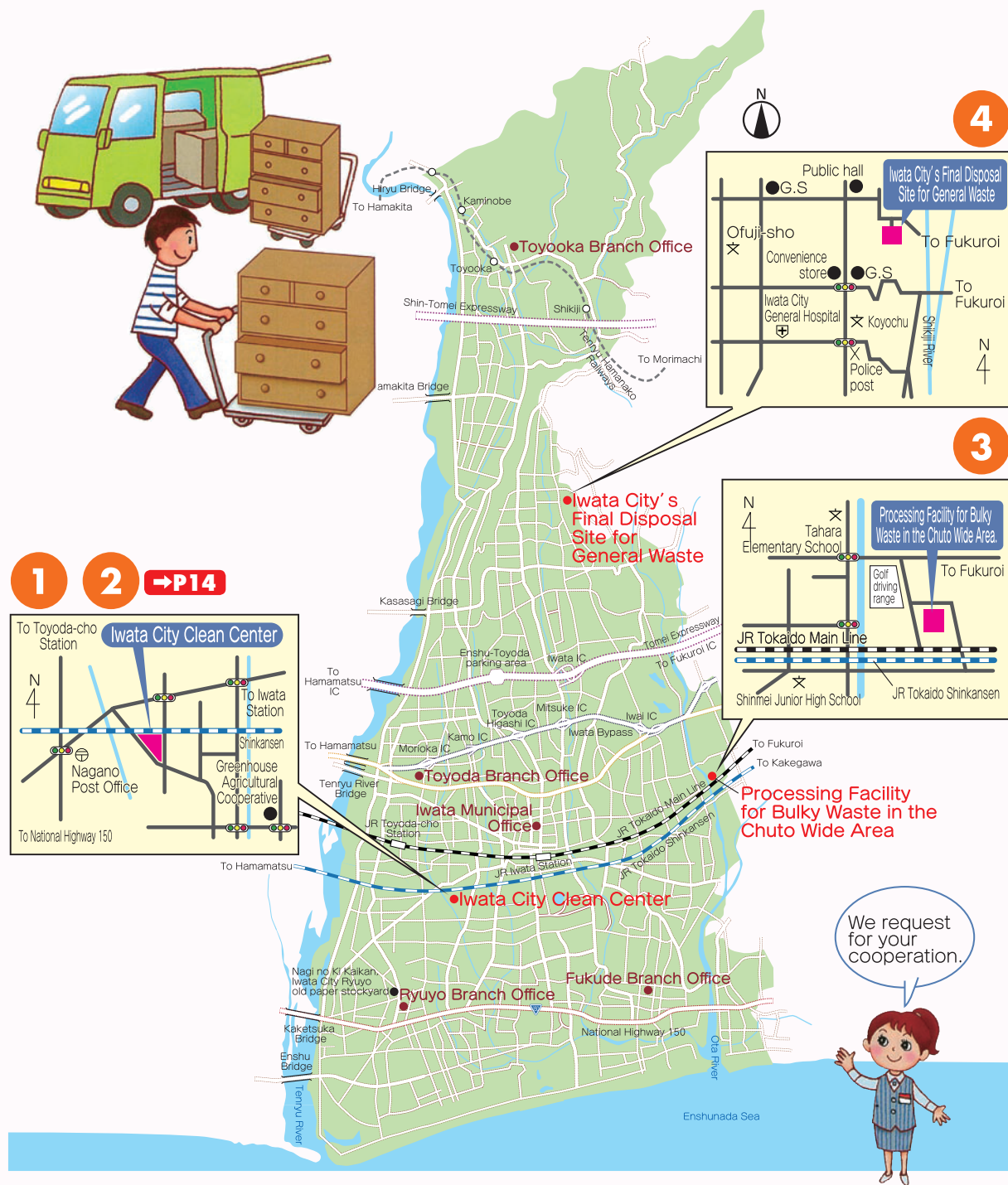

Collection of Bulky Waste by Household

Charges Apply

For families who do not have the means to transport bulky waste generated from their homes, the city offers chargeable household collection services.

Household collection is on a reservation basis via telephone and the collection date is determined in the order the reservation is made. The collection date is between Mon and Fri (excluding public holidays and New Year Holidays).

Bulky waste to be collected has to be carried outside the house prior to the collection (outdoors on the ground floor for apartment buildings).



1 Things that can be collected

Size : The longest must not exceed 2m and the weight must be 80kg or less

Examples of objects that can be collected

- Cabinet, futon, bicycle, writing desk, bed, mattress, organ, sofa, etc.
- When placed in bags, sort the waste in the same way as when taking it out for regular collection. Use the designated bags or transparent bags that allow the contents to be checked and make sure each bag is light enough to be carried by one person.
- Applicable products under the Household Appliance Recycling Law (TVs, air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, clothes dryer)
 - ※For applicable products under the Household Appliance Recycling Law, make payment for the recycling charges at the post office before the collection day and get ready the recycling coupon. See P18 for the household appliance recycling charges. **→P16**

Objects that cannot be collected : Waste that exceed the stipulated length and weight and waste that cannot be processed by the city (waste that cannot be taken out to the waste collection points and waste other than ① and ② in **P10**)

2 Collection charges

Basic charges : Basic charge 1,020 yen per vehicle 206 yen per item collected

(Example) For 4 collected items, the charge is 1,020 yen + (206 yen x 4) = 1,840 yen (rounded to the nearest 10 yen)

※For applicable products under the Household Appliance Recycling Law, an amount of 1,080 yen per item will be added as transport charges to the designated transaction center.

Payment method : Cash payment upon collection (prepare exact amount)

●Exemption from payment is available

- Households with members who have been issued with the Level 1-3 Physical Disability Certificate (excluding separated households)
 - Households with members who are all above 70 years old (excluding separated households)
- Cases corresponding to the above which have been issued with the tax exemption application by the district welfare officer shall be exempted from the basic charge of 1,020 yen.

※Collection charges are subject to change and valid as of Apr 2017.

3 Application method etc.

Application period : 1 week before the preferred date as a general rule (your preferred date may not be available depending on the reservation status)

Apply to : Waste Treatment Department ☎0538-37-4812

(information such as your address, name, telephone no. and the type, quantity and size of the waste to be taken out will be asked)

Things to note : During collection, you or a family member needs to be present.

Bulky waste to be collected has to be carried outside the house prior to the collection (outdoors on the ground floor for apartment buildings) as the collection staff will not enter your home to move the waste. As a general rule, each household is limited to only one collection per month.



Recycling Stations

Free of Charge

For those who can't take out their waste to the waste collection point at the fixed time, they may bring the waste to the recycling stations which collect resource waste free-of-charge.

1 Waste that can be taken out

Empty cans, empty bins, pet bottles, plastic containers and packaging, waste cooking oil, old paper (newspaper, magazines, miscellaneous paper, cardboard), old clothing

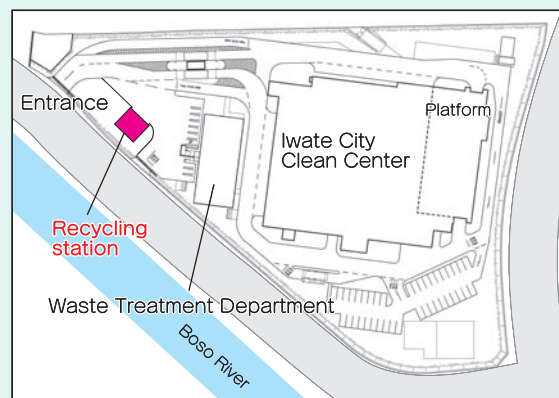

Recycling of PCs and Mobile Phone

Dispose of your PC and mobile phone that are no longer in use at home using one of the following methods.

1 Make use of the collection boxes installed at public facilities


Free of charge

Applicable items : Notebook PCs (including tablet terminals), mobile phones, PHS terminals and their accessories (mouse, keyboard, speaker, cable etc. that are attached as standard accessories to the main unit during purchase)

※Peripheral devices such as printers and scanners, and dedicated word processors are not applicable and should be treated as **“Metal Fittings, Small Electrical Appliances”** → P8

※PCs that cannot enter the collection boxes will be collected only at the receiving counter of the Clean Center.

Things to note when using the boxes : Remove all personal information beforehand.

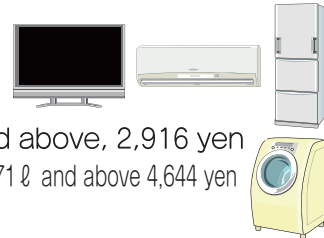

Q&A on How to Take Out Waste

Q1 How do you take out branches from the pruning of garden trees?

A Cut the branches pruned from trees into pieces about 50cm long and put them into the designated bags or tie them up in a bundle that can be handled by one person with a string. Stick a collection coupon directly onto the bundle and take them out on the day for "Flammable Waste". Up to 2 bags (bundles) can be taken out each time. If the quantity is too much, divide it up into batches to be taken out separately, or self-carry them (charges apply / **P11** 1 Flammable Waste) or use the household collection service for bulky waste (charges apply / **P13**)



Burning off a field is prohibited

Q2 How can I take out my futon, carpet and blanket to the collection points?

A As the items may get stuck and block the entrance of the incinerator if they are not cut up, cut them up into pieces with an approximate size of a seat cushion and put them into the designated bags. If they cannot go into the bags, tie them up into a bundle with a string and paste a collection coupon onto it.



- ※Do not cut up down-filled futon but tie it up with a string so that it does not open before taking it out.
- ※If the futon cannot be cut up, self-carry it (charges apply / **P11** 1 Flammable Waste) or use the household collection service for bulky waste offered by the city (charges apply / **P13**).
- ※Note that electric blankets and mattresses (with springs, magnets inside) are not "Flammable Waste".

- Electric futon → Metal fittings, small electrical appliances **P8**
- Mattress (with springs inside) → Metal fittings, small electrical appliances **P8**
- Mattress (with magnets inside) → Landfill waste **P9**

Q3 How can I take out my hose, packaging tape, vinyl sheet, etc., to the collection points?

A As the items may spread open during the treatment process and impede the operation of the incinerator if they are not folded or bundled up, make sure you cut them up into pieces not exceeding 50cm in size before taking them out.
※If the items cannot be cut up, take them out on the day for “Landfill Waste” or self-carry them to the Clean Center (charges apply / **P11 1** Flammable Waste).

Q4 How do I dispose of my spray cans and gas cylinders for portable gas stoves containing leftover gas?

A For spray cans and cassette stove canisters that still have contents inside, pay attention to the following three points, **first remove all of the contents**, but do not punch any holes, and put them in the spray can container as empty cans.

- ① Make sure these are carried out outdoors
- ② Make sure you do so in a place with good ventilation
- ③ Make sure there are no traces of fire first before doing so

【How to Release the Gas in a Gas Cylinder for Portable Gas Stoves】

- ① Remove the cap and press the nozzle tip against a stone or concrete material (make sure the cylinder is turned upside down)
- ② The vaporized gas will flow out (about 10 minutes if it has not been used)
- ③ Shake the cylinder and check that there is no sound of liquid sloshing around inside (there will be no sound if the contents are completely emptied)

※Stop working immediately if you feel unwell while working.
※If the quantity is large, divide it up into several batches to be worked on over several days.



Q5 For “plastic containers and packaging whose stains cannot be removed with light washing” that can be taken out as flammable waste, to what extent must it be stained?

A These are items with stains that cannot be removed without using a large amount of water or washing detergent. Plastic containers and packaging with such stains can be taken out as “Flammable Waste”. However, those which can be cleaned with light washing shall be taken out as “Plastic Containers and Packaging”.

Q6 Do I have to sort out the empty cans into aluminium and steel cans? Also, do I have to crush the cans before taking them out?

A As the empty cans will be sorted out into aluminium and steel cans at the processing facilities, there is no need to sort them before taking them out. There is also no particular need to crush them. If collection of resources is carried out independently by neighbourhood councils separate from the collection by the city, follow the instructions of the neighbourhood council instead.

Q7 How should I dispose of waste generated by fires and natural disasters?

A Sort out waste generated by disasters and self-carry them to the various processing facilities (**P11**). Transport vehicles shall be limited to those under two tons.

You can request for exemption from paying the processing charges by applying for tax relief.

● When damage is caused by fire in residential housing

You can be exempted from the processing charges if you have a Disaster Victim Certificate issued by the Fire Department.

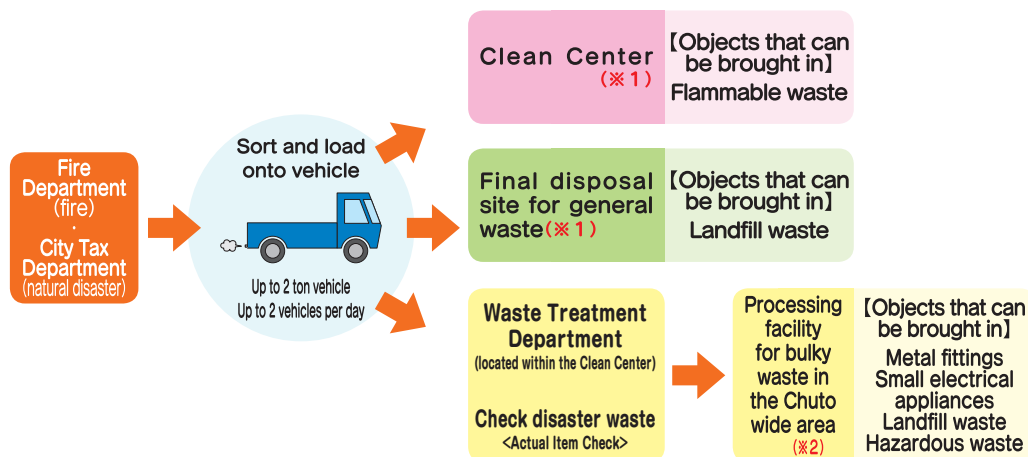
● When residential housing and objects are damaged by natural disasters

You can be exempted from the processing charges if you have a Disaster Victim Certificate issued by the City Tax Department.

In the event of a natural disaster that results in damages to many households, you will be exempted from the processing charges even without a Disaster Victim Certificate for a limited period after the disaster.

【Self-carry Procedure using a Disaster Victim Certificate】



※1 The applicant shall fill in a tax relief form for disaster waste and submit it to the reception counter in the various facilities in person. (For waste to be brought in on a Sat, Sun or public holiday, the tax relief form needs to be issued and received from the Waste Treatment Department (Clean Center) between Mon and Fri.)

※2 If transporting waste yourself to the processing facility for bulky waste in the Chuto wide area, staff from the Waste Treatment Department will check disaster waste in advance and issue a certificate, so please bring that certificate with you when transporting the waste to the processing facility for bulky waste in the Chuto wide area.

Q8 How should I take out a smoking-type insecticide container?

A After fully using up the contents, sort them out according to the material.

● **Plastic containers** : Container → “**Plastic Containers and Packaging**”

Parts containing the chemicals → “**Landfill Waste**”

● **Metal cans** : Outer cans → “**Empty Cans**”

Inner cans (parts containing the chemicals)

→ “**Landfill Waste**”



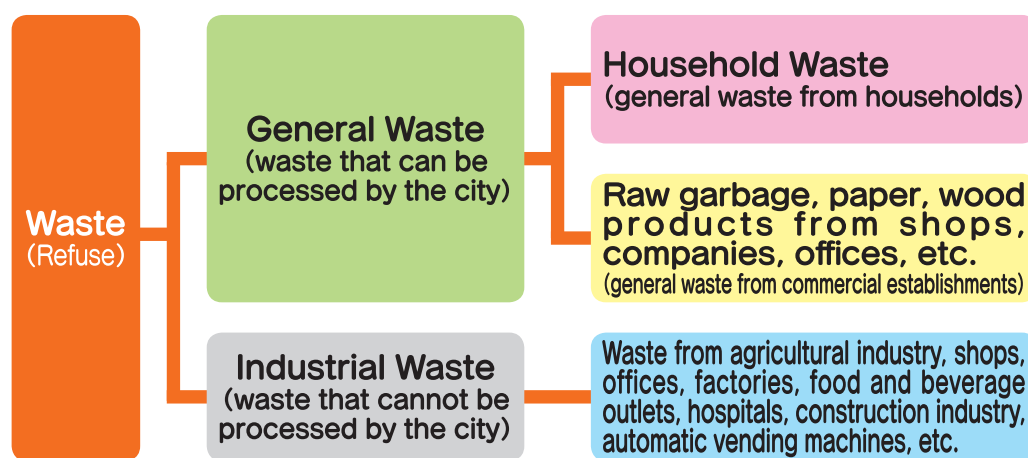
※The outer and inner cans can be separated with a can opener.

Q9 How do I dispose of the machinery and vinyl sheets that I used for farming purposes previously?

A Machinery and vinyl sheets used for farming purposes are considered as industrial waste and thus cannot be processed by the city. Engage the services of the retail store or a professional operator licensed to handle industrial waste. (See **P10** for details on commercial waste)

Q10 How do I dispose of the wooden and concrete materials from the renovation or demolition of old buildings in reconstructing housing and warehouses?

A Waste generated from construction work such as those by building demolition operators are considered as industrial waste and thus cannot be processed by the city. Engage the services of the operator carrying out the construction work.

For waste generated by self-demolition work, self-carry them to the various processing facilities (**P11**).

※Up to two units per household
- **Application Documents**
 - (1) Application form for grant to subsidize the installation cost of composting container for raw garbage
 - (2) Invoice for grant to subsidize the installation cost of composting container for raw garbage

◆ Subsidy system for projects involving the group collection of resources such as old paper

A subsidy depending on the amount collected is granted to organizations that have carried out group collection of resources within the city so as to promote the recycling of resources such as old paper etc. and stimulate local activity.

Prior group registration is required to receive the subsidy granted.



- **Targeted Organizations** Not-for-profit organizations in the city such as the neighbourhood council, PTA, children's club, etc.
- **Targeted Articles** Old paper, old cloth, empty cans, empty bottles
- **Subsidized Amount** 4 yen per kg (rounded to the nearest 10 yen)
- **Application Documents**
 - (1) Group registration Application form to register as an organization for the collection of resources such as old paper
 - (2) Subsidy application
 - Submit the application documents **within 30 days** after carrying out the resource collection
 - Subsidy application form-cum-report for projects involving the group collection of resources such as old paper
 - Invoice
 - Measurement voucher

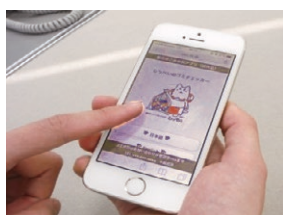



Residential Medical Waste

Most residential medical waste pose a low risk of infection but some may carry a risk of infecting others with infectious diseases due to needle-stick injuries caused by injection needles. Follow the following sorting classification when taking out your waste to the waste collection point.

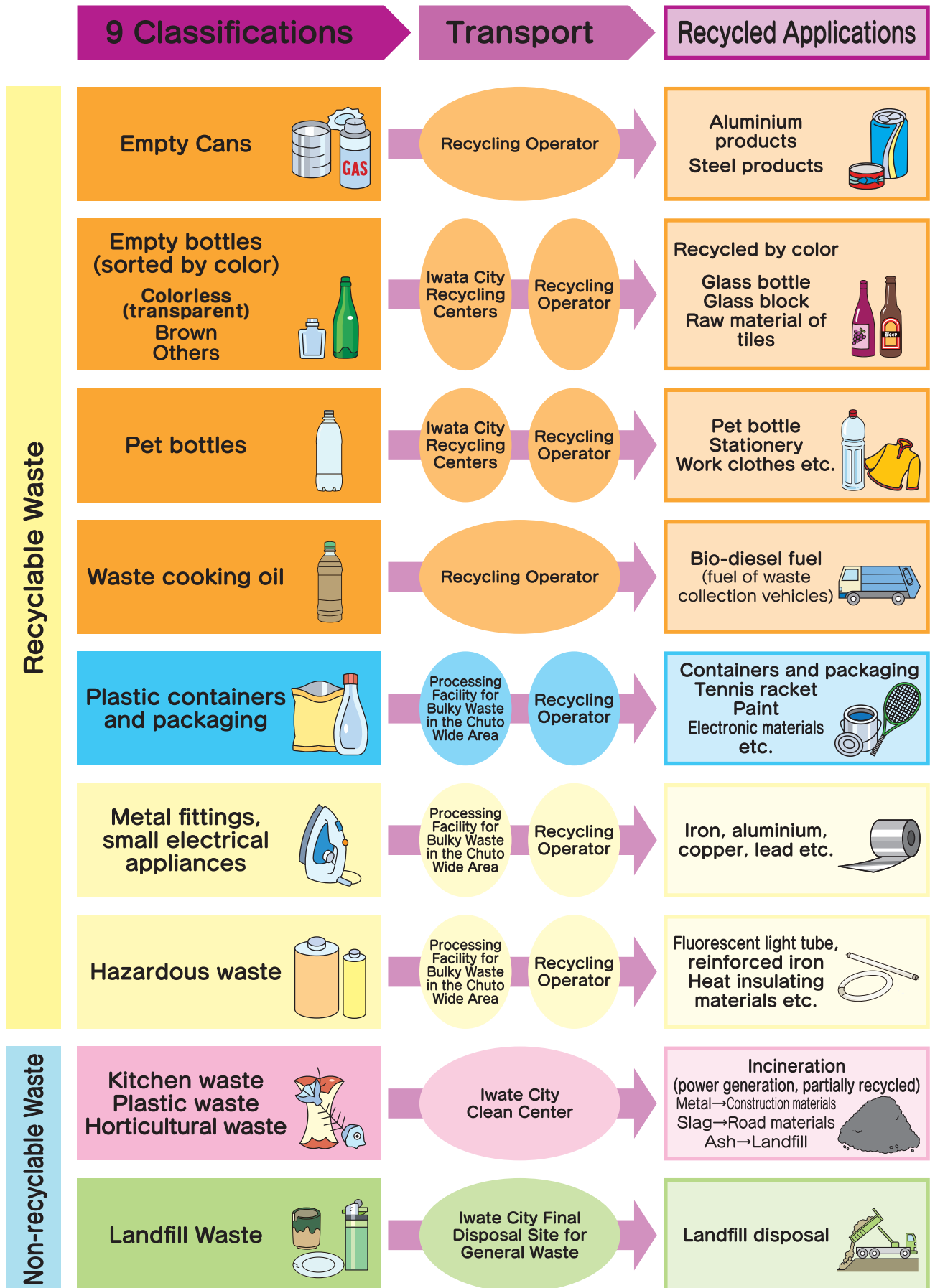

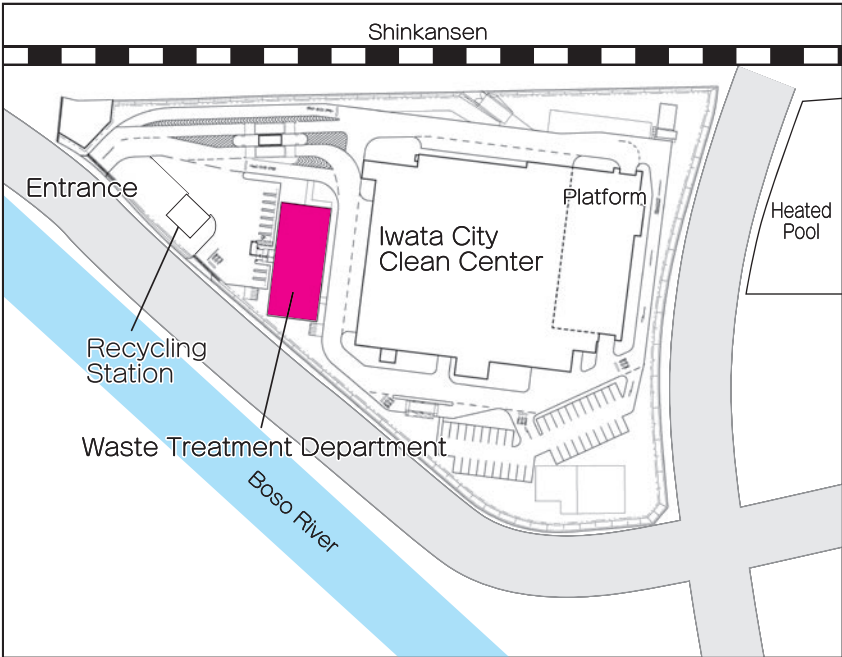
